Nonlinear Processes in Geophysics is an international, interdisciplinary journal for the publication of original research involving nonlinear processes in geophysics in the broadest sense.

This would include but not be restricted to: tectonophysics, seismology, volcanology, sedimentation, hydrological sciences, oceanography and atmospheric sciences, including air-sea and air-land-vegetation interactions, bio-chemical processes and climatology, space physics and natural hazards.

Contributions from both dynamical systems theorists and geophysicists that apply scaling and fractals, chaos, nonlinear time series analysis, nonlinear predictability, turbulence and diffusion, nonlinear waves and solitons, coherent structures and vortex dynamics, or inverse problems in nonlinear dynamics to fundamental problems in geophysics are welcome.

The journal will maintain sections for regular length articles, brief communications (letters) and commentary.
